#### 1. The Need

#### The reality is that some members of our community often feel like they're riding a rollercoaster.

Speeding downhill on a track fraught with stigma, isolation and exclusion, they land at the bottom with a jolt, out of breath and exhausted. Then mustering strength and determination, they make the challenging climb back uphill where they face a constant stream of bureaucracy, paperwork, waiting rooms and so much more.

The Flying Fox team does all that it can to be there along the ride. We hold hands tightly on the scary downhills. We do our bit to help guide the cart back uphill. We counter stigma with warmth. We eradicate isolation with connection. We combat exclusion with love and joy. We refuse to create difficulties, but rather provide a sense of ease.

Joining the Flying Fox community is simple and uncomplicated. We welcome our Buddies and Campers with open arms and big hearts. We are a group of passionate young people who just want to have fun and we've devoted our lives to doing just that.

We have spent the last nine years building a community so that no one ever feels like they are riding roller coaster ups and downs alone. At Flying Fox, we come together to create moments that allow our community to embrace all that life has to offer.

#### 2022 was financially significant for us for multiple reasons.

Firstly, we settled on our second home in Rosebud (House 2.0) thanks to the enormous generosity of our wider Flying Fox family. This has enabled us to scale our programs, minimise rental costs and ultimately bolster our balance sheet. 2022 also saw our highest number of prorams which delivered strong program revenue, while we were pleasingly awarded a large number of community grants.

2023 will see us continue to invest in our ability to deliver more amazing programs while best leveraging the assets at our disposal.

We are committed to maximising our impact each and every day but in a financially sustainable and responsible way.
